Each summer we go to the Washington County Fair to paint faces with simple pictures while sharing the Gospel through the Wordless Book with hundreds of children. In the past few years, it has become more and more difficult to get the rental trailer to the fair on time, and to have a set-up that is both visually appealing and welcoming, while reassuring parents that their children are safe inside.

At the last board meeting a lengthy discussion resulted in some creative ideas for the fair ministry in the future. One of the things that was agreed upon was that having a vehicle with large windows would create a sense of reassurance for the parents. An omnibus much like the one pictured below would allow for ministry to be done in an open space where children would be visible to those on the outside.

Perhaps you know of a similar vehicle for sale. Maybe you would like to contribute toward the purchase of a used vehicle. An added feature is that this type of vehicle could be used to transport equipment and food to camp and it could also be used for ministry at parks and other festivals.
