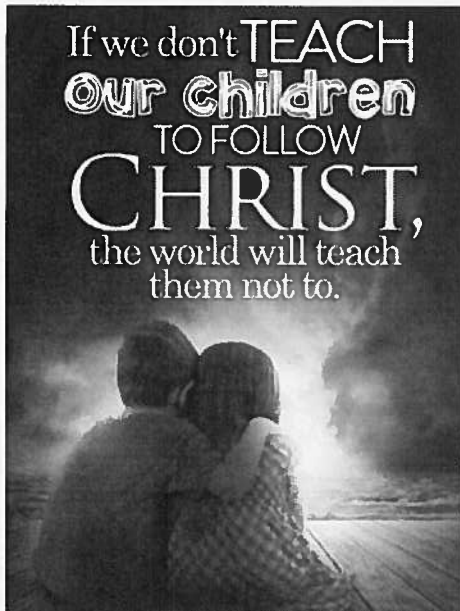

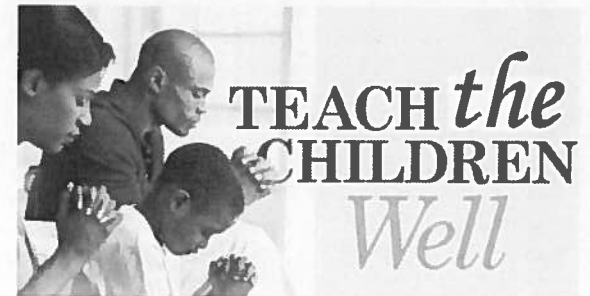

The children will soon be out of school for the summer. For the most part, they will put away their academic books and spend their days in carefree pleasure.

Although academics are very important to thrive and survive in society, we desire to see children thrive in their Christian walk. This doesn't happen without intentional effort to reach them and teach them from God's Word. If we do not teach them the truth of God's Word while they are children, it will be necessary to teach and re-teach them as adults, and statistics prove THAT is the more difficult job. On average, eighty-six percent of the congregation of any Bible-believing and preaching church will tell you they were saved as a child under the age of fourteen.

Throughout the summer, we will be taking the Word of God and the Bible lesson series, *Knowing Christ*, into neighborhoods, community buildings, churches, and anywhere else children gather. We have just a couple of open dates and times on our calendar for others who want to invite the children in to learn. You provide the place and a simple snack. We will do the rest.
